Richard M. Rosenfeld is Professor and Chairman of Otolaryngology at SUNY Downstate Medical Center, Chair of the Guideline Development Task Force for the American Academy of Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery (AAO-HNS), and Editor in Chief of Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery Journal. Dr. Rosenfeld has 20 years of experience with systematic reviews and guideline development, including work with the American Medical Association, American Academy of Pediatrics, AAO-HNS, Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, ENT Cochrane Center, and the NY State Department of Health. He has given over 500 scientific presentations and is author, coauthor, or editor of 5 books and 230 scientific publications. Dr. Rosenfeld has been listed for 10 years as one of “America’s Best Doctors” by Castle Connolly. He is Chair of the Guidelines International Network (G-I-N) North American Community (G-I-N NA) and Chair of the Scientific Program for the 2011 G-I-N Annual Conference.
